**BEFORE : THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE RENE WILLIAMS  
(IN CHAMBERS WITHOUT A HEARING)**

**UPON THIS CLAIM** filed herein on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2025

**AND UPON** the claimant being heard by the court on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2025

**AND UPON** the Defendants all being resident outside of Antigua and Barbuda

**AND UPON IT APPEARING** that the Defendants may have been served but none of them have filed an Acknowledgement of Service

**AND UPON THE COURT** being concerned as to whether:

1. The court has jurisdiction in the circumstances where none of the defendants appear to reside within the jurisdiction and most of the allegations in the claim appear to relate to acts occurring outside of Antigua and Barbuda.
2. The allegations contained in the claim disclose a reasonable cause of action in accordance with the laws of Antigua and Barbuda against the Defendants

**AND UPON THE COURT NOTING** that the Claimant although an experienced businessman is not represented by counsel and his filings to date reveal a lack of familiarity with court procedures in Antigua and Barbuda

**AND UPON THE COURT** requiring the assistance of the Honourable Attorney General to provide impartial advice on the issues raised by the claim

**AND UPON THE COURT** making this order on its own initiative pursuant to CPR Rule 26.2(1)

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Honourable Attorney General is hereby appointed as Amicus.
2. The Court Office shall generate an access code to enable the Attorney General's Chambers to access all filings on the e-litigation portal.
3. The bailiff of the High Court shall serve Notice of Access Code as well as Notice of Hearing and a copy of this order on the Attorney General's Chambers and shall also serve Notice of Hearing on the Claimant.
4. The matter is adjourned to 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2025 for further directions.
5. The Claimant shall have carriage of this order.
