**NOTICE OF PRIOR RECUSAL DEMANDS, RECORD-BASED CONFLICT
ALLEGATIONS, AND DEMAND FOR IMMEDIATE RECUSAL RULING**

Interested Party Alkiviades Andrew David IV respectfully gives notice that recusal-related demands, disability-access objections, preservation demands, and record-integrity objections are already on the docket and have not been addressed through any evidentiary inquiry or reasoned recusal analysis. See, inter alia, ECF Nos. 73, 83, 108, 112, 125, 126, 131, 132, and 133.

The docket reflects that the Court treated Mr. David's recusal and preservation requests as denied or disregarded under filing restrictions, including ECF Nos. 97, 109, 113, 128, and 136. The undersigned therefore preserves all objections under 28 U.S.C. §§ 144 and 455, the Due Process Clause, the ADA, and the Court's inherent duty to maintain public confidence in impartial proceedings.

The conflict allegations are record-based. The Texas First Amended Complaint and related filings identify the Gloria Allred, Erbil Gunasti, Turkish Consulate in Los Angeles, John Quirk, Ehud Barak-linked lawfare, Yildirim/Yilport, Alfa Nero, Asot Michael, and Antigua and Barbuda sovereign-asset pathways. The undersigned does not ask the Court to make criminal findings in this notice; he demands that the Court stop ignoring docketed conflict allegations that bear directly on impartiality, preservation, and sovereign interference.

Because the Court has restricted filings while simultaneously denying or disregarding recusal, accommodation, preservation, and record-integrity submissions, a reasonable observer could question whether the judicial machinery is being used to suppress the record rather than adjudicate it. The undersigned further gives notice that he is preserving the matter for appellate review, judicial-misconduct review, and referral to appropriate authorities if the Court continues to proceed without addressing recusal.

Requested relief: immediate recusal or, at minimum, a written ruling identifying each docketed recusal ground considered and the reason for denial; preservation of all sealed, stricken, and restricted materials; and no further adverse action against the undersigned until recusal and disability-accommodation issues are decided on the record.
